We are writing regarding the two orphan counties in Colorado, Montezuma and La Plata. These two counties are currently denied the ability to obtain in-state broadcasts due to the existing inflexibility and structure of the Designated Market Areas (DMA). As the FCC commences its investigation on the subject of orphan counties, we write to express our commitment to secure the citizens of these counties the ability to view local and state programming including, but not limited to, news, weather and public emergency notifications. This issue is critical to the residents of these counties, as their inability to receive local and state broadcasts has rendered them isolated from their native state.


During the last three years, this bipartisan matter has garnered both the support of the Colorado Congressional Delegation and the State of Colorado. In 2008 and 2010, the Colorado State Legislature passed resolutions urging the FCC and the federal government to address the longstanding issue of orphan counties in Colorado. 




